## CONFESSION AND ASSURANCE OF PARDON

*"All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23), but - because of the death and resurrection of Jesus - "if we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9). Confession of our sin and then reveling in the assurance God gives us of His forgiveness through Jesus is something that God's people ought to engage in daily, and this is why we do it each week when we gather.*

Prayer of Public Confession: **Merciful God, we confess that we have not loved you with our whole heart. We often fail in our attempts to be obedient. We have not always done your will, and we often rebel against you. We have not loved our neighbors as we should, and we sometimes miss opportunities to proclaim your gospel to others. Please forgive us through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.**

Assurance of Pardon (1 John 4:9-10)

MINISTER: Hear the promises of God to those who truly repent of their sins and trust in Christ: *In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.*

**ALL: Thanks be to God.**

## SCRIPTURE READING

*We believe the Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments, to be the inspired word of God, without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men, and the divine and final authority for all Christian faith and life. Therefore, we give the reading of Scripture a high place in our worship services.*

### 1 John 4:16-21

So, we have come to know and to believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and whoever abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. 17 By this is love perfected with us, so that we may have confidence for the day of judgment, because as he is so also are we in this world. 18 There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love. 19 We love because he first loved us. 20 If anyone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen. 21 And this commandment we have from him: whoever loves God must also love his brother.
